

Employee Assistance Program (EAP)

The Employee Assistance Program will now be administered by Anthem EAP. Counseling, referral services, crisis assistance, legal and financial consultations and care resources will be available 24 hours a day for you and your eligible household members. You can get a referral to a local licensed professional for one-on-one consultation. Anthem EAP has a state network of providers. You do not need to be enrolled in the Anthem health plan to access this coverage. All benefits eligible employees and their household family member can use the EAP program.
