

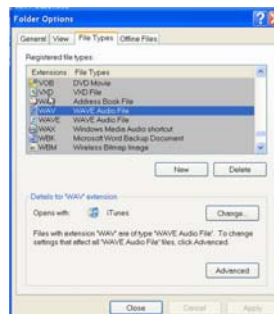
Changing your default WAV player on a PC

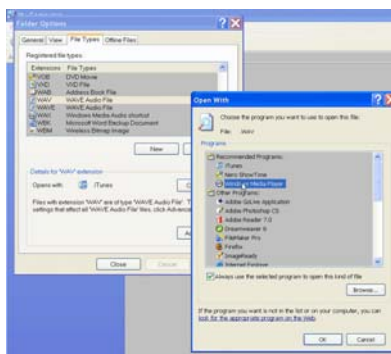
If you use iTunes as your default music player, opening your voicemail WAV files will result in your voicemail being imported into your music library. If you would like to change this, you can easily make Windows Media Player your default WAV player.



Double Click on My Computer
Select the Tools drop-down menu
Click on Folder Options



Click on the File Types Tab
Scroll down and click once on WAV in the Extensions list



In the "Details for WAV Extension" area, click on the Change Button.

Select Windows Media Player from the list of available programs.

Click Okay. Close the Folder Options and My Computer Window.

You are now ready to listen to your voicemail messages in Windows Media Player. If you use iTunes as your default MP3 player, you will still be able to listen to your music library as usual.
