

**Honors Project – Academic-Year Schedule  
August 2023 to May 2024**

\*\* Students and Committees Must Meet All Deadlines\*\*

**FALL 2023**

August 30	Classes begin
<b>August 31</b>	<b>Honors Project proposals due by the end of the day (11:59 pm).</b>
September 4-8	Department faculty meet to evaluate Honors proposals and decide which projects to accept. The department assigns an Honors Advisor and Second Reader for each accepted project. Students are notified about the status of their proposals before the end of ADD/DROP (Sept. 13).
October 2	Students should have met with their Honors Committee by this date, with the meeting scheduled by the student's Honors Advisor.
December 8	Last day of classes
<b>December 12</b>	<b>Drafts of two completed chapters due by the end of the day (11:59 pm),</b> the last day of Reading Period. Chapters should be submitted electronically to Honors Committee members.

**SPRING 2024**

January 22	Classes begin
<b>March 7</b>	<b>Complete Honors Project due by the end of the day (11:59 pm).</b> The full draft must be submitted to the Honors Committee electronically.
March 8-25	Spring break begins after last class on Friday, March 8 and ends before 8:30 am on Monday, March 25.
March 25-28	The Honors Committee evaluates whether the complete draft shows sufficient progress to continue as an Honors Project. By March 28 the advisor has notified the student of the committee's determination.
March 29	By this date the Honors Advisor or the entire Committee has met with the student to offer feedback, and the meeting is initiated by the student's Honors Advisor.
<b>April 29</b>	<b>Final Honors paper due by the end of the day (11:59 pm).</b> It should be submitted electronically to the Department Chair and Academic Department Coordinator, and will be read by all Department of Anthropology faculty.
May 8	Last day of classes
<b>May 9-10</b>	<b>Student presents Honors Project to Department.</b> All Anthropology faculty attend the presentation and decide whether to award the project Honors. The presentation may be open to the public, at the student's discretion.
May 16	Final version of the Honors paper must be uploaded in electronic format to H-L Library site and a required form completed. Check the Library's deadline and formatting instructions.
