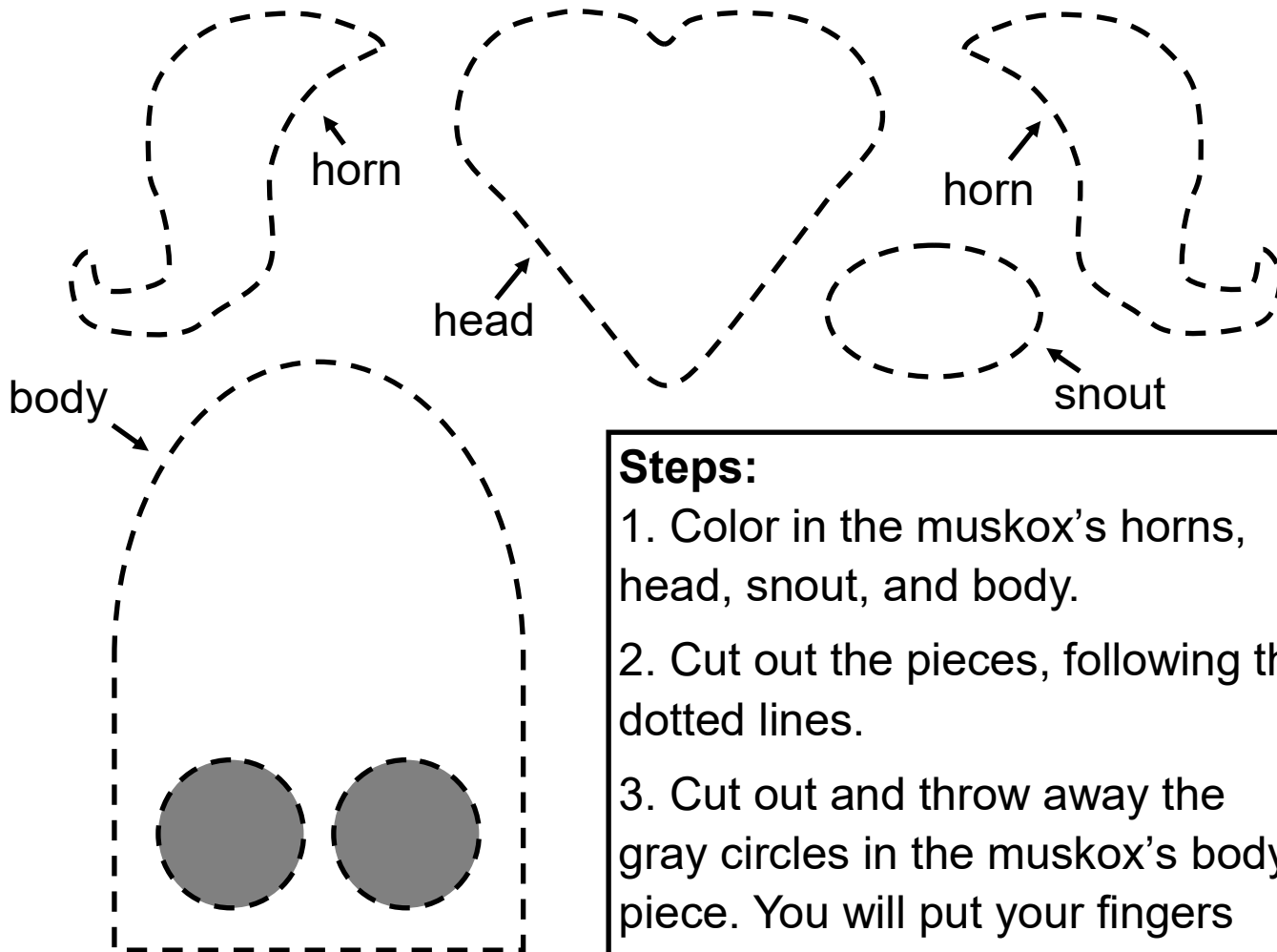


Muskox Finger Puppet!

You'll need:
-scissors
-crayons, markers, or colored pencils
-glue or tape



Steps:

1. Color in the muskox's horns, head, snout, and body.
2. Cut out the pieces, following the dotted lines.
3. Cut out and throw away the gray circles in the muskox's body piece. You will put your fingers through these holes to give your muskox legs.

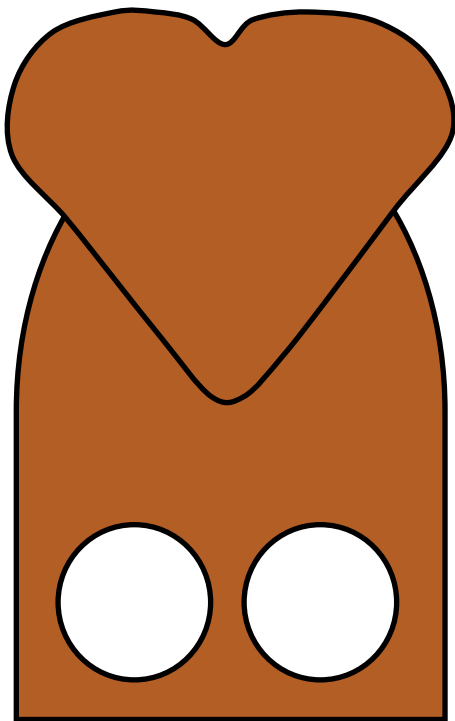
TIP: After cutting out the body and finger holes, glue the body to thicker paper. Once the glue is dry, cut out the body again, following the outline of the body and the finger holes. This will make the body sturdier.

Did You Know?

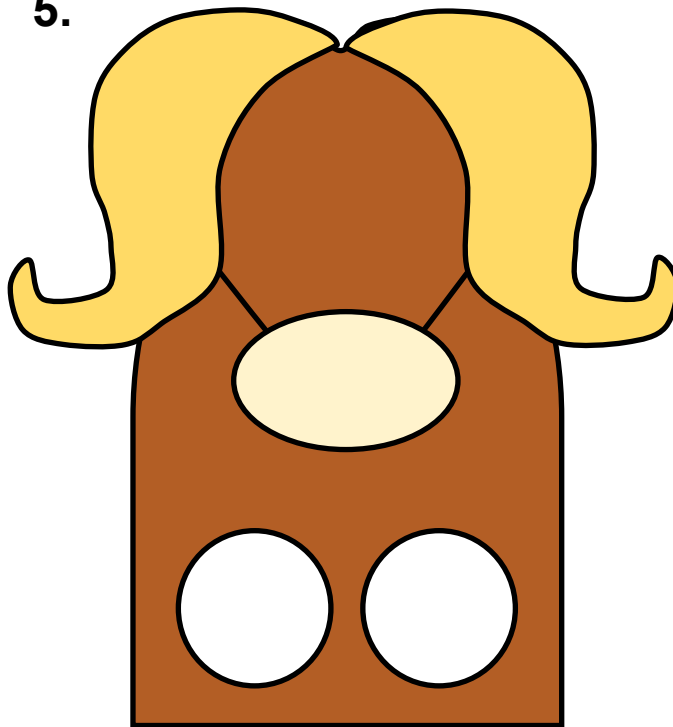
- Muskoxen are more closely related to goats than to oxen.
- In the Inuit language called Inuktitut, the word for muskox is *umingmak*, which means "bearded one."

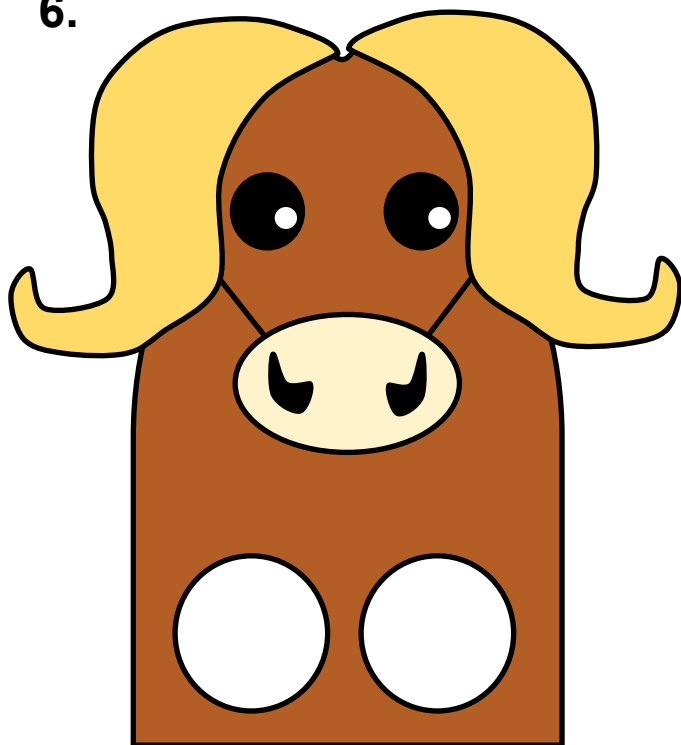

Steps:

4. Glue the head to the body.

5. Glue the horns to the sides of the head and glue the snout to the bottom of the head.

6. Draw eyes and nostrils on the head and snout. Put your fingers through the holes to give your muskox legs!
