Make a Snowy Painting with Watercolors & Salt!

Can't get enough of the wintry sight of thousands of delicate snowflakes filling the sky? With just watercolor paints, watercolor paper and table salt you can create an amazing painting of a crystalline snowstorm right at home.

You'll need:

- watercolor paper
- watercolor paints
- water
- paintbrushes
- table salt
- tape



Just before you add the salt, the paint on the paper should still look somewhat shiny and wet, but not sopping wet.



Tape the four corners of your watercolor paper to the surface you will be working on. This will keep the paper from curling up once you start painting.



Take a pinch of table salt and sprinkle it across the still-wet paint. A little salt goes a long way!




Using the watercolor paints, water and paintbrushes, paint large areas of color across the paper. Dark paint colors work best for this project.



Let the paper dry and brush off the salt grains.



It is important to work quickly, because you do not want the paint to dry on the paper before you add the salt to your painting.



Look closely to see the beautiful "snowflakes" on your paper! Each salt grain pulls the water and pigment towards it as it dries, creating the snowflake effect.
