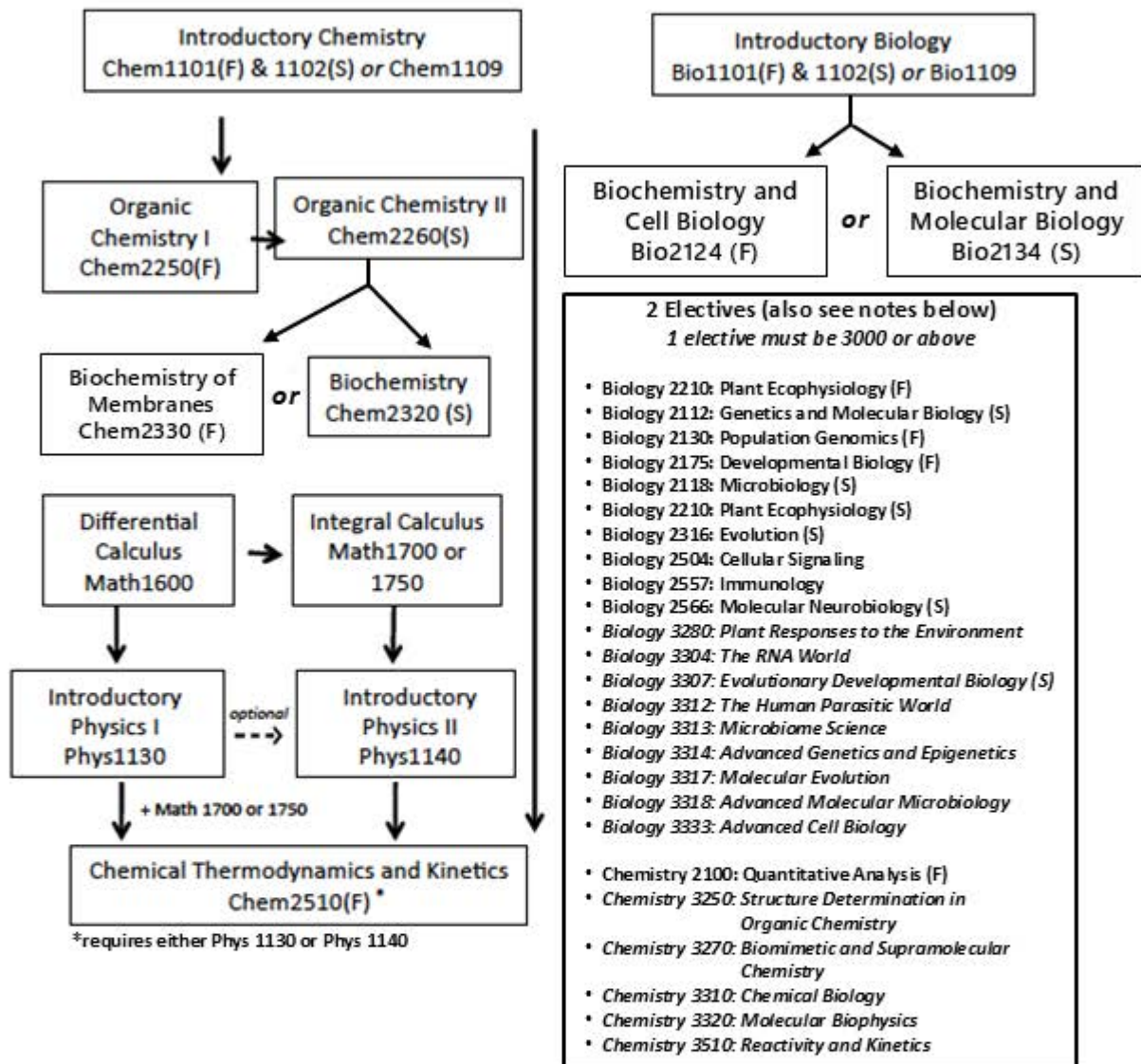


Navigating the Biochemistry major



- In planning your Biochemistry major, check the course catalogue or Workday for prerequisites for elective courses.
- Upper-level elective courses (italics) are not necessarily offered every year. If you intend to use a course as a Biochemistry elective, we recommend that you check with the professor to determine when the course will be offered.
- Biology, Chemistry, and Biochemistry courses taken during study away may count as electives for the Biochemistry major, but they must be approved in advance. Study away credits may not be used to replace required non-elective courses at the 2000-level or above—these courses must be taken at Bowdoin.
- Newly offered courses not shown on the electives list may also count toward the Biochemistry major. If you have a question about whether a newly offered course can count as an elective for the Biochemistry major, please contact the Biochemistry Program Director.
