## Working Days

During the summer, 19 days represents full-time work for one month or a $1 / 9^{\text {th }}$ payment. Below is the breakdown of days worked to 9 ths earned:

- $0.5 / 9^{\text {th }}=9.5$ days
- $1 / 9^{\text {th }}=19$ days
- $1.5 / 9^{\text {ths }}=28.5$ days
- $2 / 9^{\text {ths }}=38$ days
- $2.5 / 9^{\text {ths }}=47.5$ days
- $3 / 9^{\text {ths }}=57$ days
