

Bowdoin College Fertility Benefit

Coverage	Medical, laboratory and pharmacy services are covered through the specified number of treatment cycles. Bowdoin College's fertility benefit approves 3 intrauterine insemination cycles (IUI) and 2 in vitro fertilization cycles (IVF) subject to medical necessity review. A cycle is counted from egg retrieval and unsuccessful retrievals count toward the maximum. Employees are required to enroll in FamilyPath to activate their benefits and when seeking fertility treatment. Please contact a FamilyPath Advisor at 1-866-203-8374 for more information.
Cost Sharing	
In-Network	Services covered at in-network coinsurance after deductible
Out-Network	Services covered at out-of-network coinsurance after deductible
Eligibility	An individual who has a medical or genetic condition or who is expected to undergo treatment that may directly or indirectly cause a risk of impairment to their fertility. An individual who has been diagnosed with infertility. A single female or a same sex female couple with no diagnosis of infertility. An individual who meets the requirements for elective fertility preservation. Please contact FamilyPath to help determine eligibility requirements.
Conception Coverage	Waives the requirement for a diagnosis of infertility for same sex female couples and single females
Cycle Maximums	
Intrauterine insemination (IUI)	3 cycle lifetime maximum (subject to medical necessity review)
In vitro fertilisation (IVF)	2 cycle lifetime maximum (subject to medical necessity review)
Fertility Preservation Services	Therapeutic and Elective Cryopreservation available for a maximum of 5 years
Storage Services	Gametes and embryo storage maximum of 5 years
Pre-Implantation Genetic Testing	Testing will be covered when determined to be medically supported
