

## Foreign Visitor Honorarium/Expense Reimbursement Attestation Form

The attestation below is required in order to comply with United States immigration law and applies to foreign visitors on “B” visas or “visa waivers.” As an educational institution, we can pay an honorarium and/or reimburse travel expenses to foreign visitors who enter the U.S. on certain visas, but only in defined circumstances.
