

Default Question Block

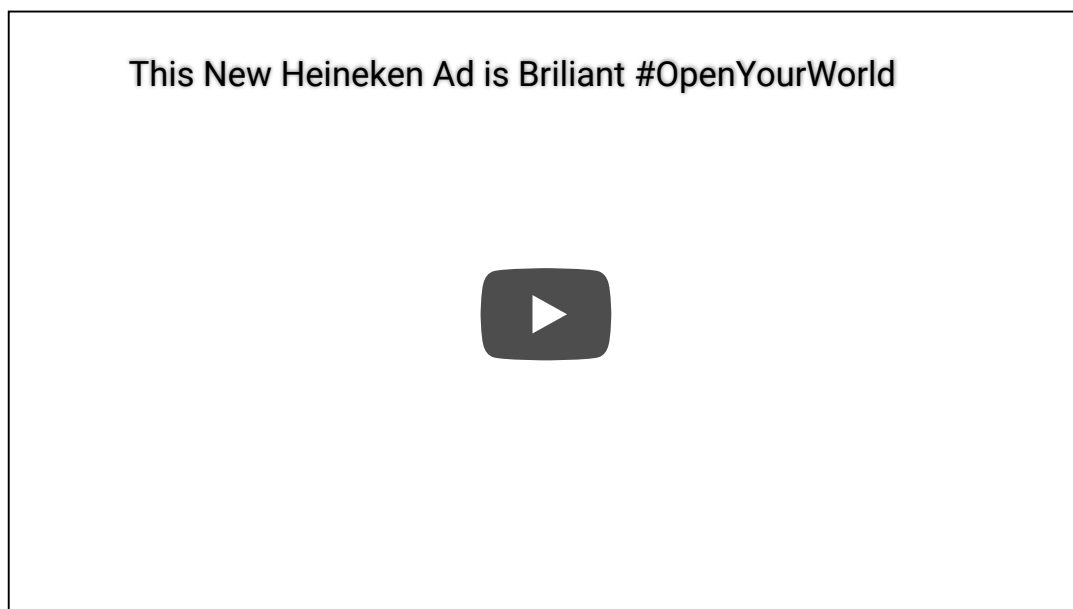
You might have heard about the echo chambers problem: that people tend to get news that confirms their point of view. Republicans get pro-Republican news, and Democrats get pro-Democrat news.

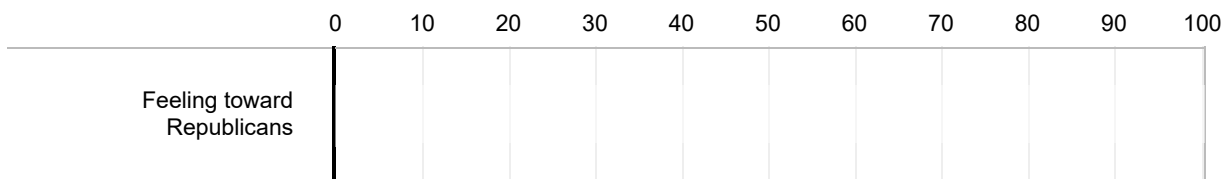

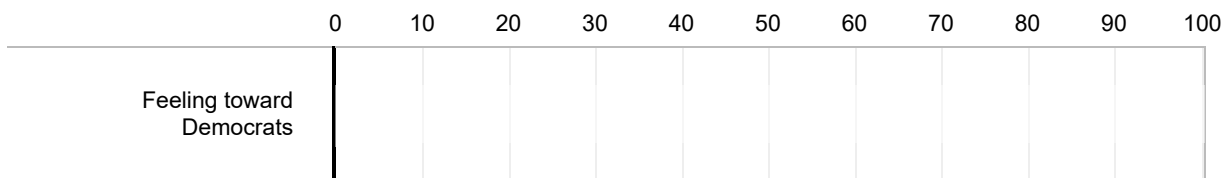
