

## Bowdoin College Spring 2019 Final Exams

Exams are scheduled based on the time block in which the class is scheduled. Morning courses will have morning exams, afternoon courses will have afternoon exams and evening courses will have evening exams. In order to schedule fairly, each set of timeblocks will cycle through their designated exam time day by day each semester. For example, if MWF 8:30 am courses have their exams on Day 1 in the morning in the fall semester, they will have their exams on Day 2 the following spring. Evening exams will always occur in the first two evenings but alternate between Day 1 and Day 2 across semesters.

The "bunching" rule itself remains unchanged: students may request to reschedule a final exam if they have three exams in two days. However, the process for requesting this change will be different. Students requesting to reschedule an exam will need to obtain a form from the Registrar's Office that verifies that they have 3 exams in two days, and present this form to their instructors when they request that a final be rescheduled. The purpose of this new process is to take the burden of checking exam schedules off of faculty and to track how often students have these exam scheduling conflicts.
