## Bowdoin College Spring 2024 Final Exam Rotation

Final Exams are scheduled based on the course's timeblock. Normally, morning courses have morning exams, afternoon courses have afternoon exams and evening courses have evening exams. For the sake of equity, each set of timeblocks cycles through their designated exam time day-by-day each semester. For example, if TR 8:30am courses have their exams on Day 1 in the morning in the fall, they will have their exams on Day 2 in the morning the following spring. The official final exam rotation and assignments are posted during the prior semester to allow faculty and students time to arrange their end-of-semester travel plans accordingly. Final exam information is available in Polaris and Classfinder in the third week of the semester after the close of the Add/Drop II registration period.
