Credit will not be given if a student places into, or elects to take CHEM 1091, 1101, or 1109. Regardless of AP score, all students must take the placement exam.

Francophone Studies	French Language & Culture	4	1*	n/a	*Must complete FRS 2305 or higher level course with a minimum grade of B-. Credit will not be given if a student places into, or elects to take, a course lower than FRS 2305. Regardless of AP score, all students must take the placement exam. No major/minor credit.
German	German Language & Culture	4	1*	n/a	*Must complete a 3000-level GER course with a minimum grade of B-. Regardless of AP score, all students must take the placement exam. No major/minor credit.
Government	U.S. Government	4	1*	n/a	*Must complete a 2000-level GOV course in the same subfield of AP with a minimum grade of B-. If a student has scores for more than one exam, only 1 total credit will be awarded. No major/minor credit.

Music	Music Theory	4	1*	*	*Students who received a minimum score of 4 on the Music Theory exam should take the music theory placement exam. Placement in Music 2403 results in one credit that is the equivalent of Music 1401. If a student earns a grade of C- or higher in Music 2403, this credit can count towards the major. Placement into Music 1401 or Music 1051 results in no credit.
Physics	Physics 1	4	0	PHYS 1130	Counts toward major; majors are exempt from taking PHYS 1130 and do not need to take an additional course to replace PHYS 1130. Minors are also exempt from taking PHYS 1130 but must take at least four Bowdoin Physics courses.

	Physics C: Mechanics	4	1*	PHYS 1130	*Must complete PHYS 1140 with a minimum grade of C-. Counts toward major; students are exempt from taking PHYS 1130 and do not need to take an additional course to replace PHYS 1130. Minors are also exempt from taking PHYS 1130 but must take at least four Bowdoin Physics courses. In order to receive AP credit, students should complete their course requirements before the end of their Junior year.
