TRANSPORTATION OPTIONS FOR BOWDOIN

- <u>The Bowdoin Shuttle</u>: This free shuttle provides safe and convenient transportation within a one-mile radius of campus. The Shuttle operates 7 days a week while the College is in Session. The hours of operation: Sunday-Wednesday 6:00 p.m. 1:00 a.m., Thursday-Friday 6:00 p.m. 1:30 a.m. The Bowdoin Shuttle (aka *Safe Ride*) can be reached at (207) 725-3337.
- <u>Bowdoin Student Government (BSG) Shuttle</u>: The BSG takes students to Freeport and Portland on Fridays, Portland on Saturdays, and Freeport and the Maine Mall (South Portland) on the first Sunday of every month for a fee of \$5. BSG <u>also</u> provides <u>free taxi rides</u> on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 11:00 p.m. to 1 a.m., and Fridays and Saturdays 11 p.m. to 2 a.m. within a one-mile radius of campus.
- The Brunswick Link is an affordable option to get around town without having to drive or rely on other methods of transportation. They are committed to reducing their carbon footprint. The bus also has the capacity to carry up to 2 bicycles, at no additional charge. The fare is \$2 for a single ride or \$5 for all day passes. The Brunswick Link map and schedule can be found on their website.
- Brunswick Taxi: The Brunswick Taxi (207-729-3688) provides rides in Brunswick, Bath, other surrounding towns, and Portland. BSG <u>also</u> provides <u>free taxi rides</u> on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 11:00 p.m. to 1 a.m., and Fridays and Saturdays 11 p.m. to 2 a.m. within a one-mile radius of campus.
- Bus and Train:
 - Metro Breez offers 13 round trips, Monday through Friday (6 round trips on Saturdays), between Portland, Yarmouth, Freeport, and Brunswick. Additionally, the BREEZ bus features free Wi-Fi, USB outlets and overhead storage. The fare ranges from \$2.00 to \$4.00 and they offer payment apps.  - Concord Coach Lines
 The bus stop is located at the Brunswick Visitor Center, 16 Station Ave. They provide connections to Boston, Logan Airport, and other destinations.
 - o Greyhound Bus also has a stop at 7-11 at 152 Maine St.
 - Amtrak station is located at the Brunswick Visitor Center at 16 Station Ave, which is within walking distance of the College.
- Car Rentals: You can rent a vehicle from <u>Enterprise Car Rental</u> located at 166 Pleasant St.
- Non-emergency Transportation: Bowdoin's Office of Safety and Security will provide on-campus and in-town transportation for students with non-emergency medical needs. Health Services provides taxi vouchers for routine student medical appointments.
- **Portland Jetport Transportation:** Brunswick Taxi (207-729-3688) single fare is \$70.00 two riders will split cost, Metro Breez Express Service, and Mermaid Transportation fare is \$49.00.
