What It Is and How to Use It

Every Bowdoin student has access to their own MyAid portal, which houses all financial aid information while students are enrolled at Bowdoin. Here's what you'll find:



Your financial aid award for current and prior years



Your cumulative loan balances



Status of your financial aid application documents



Useful information about the financial aid process, including how to apply for federal loans, how aid works when you study away, and how to apply for financial aid



Important messages pertaining to your financial aid

Check your portal regularly to ensure that the Office of Student Aid (SAO) has received all required documents from your family.

How to Set Up Your MyAid Portal

All matriculating Bowdoin students receive information about how to set up their MyAid portal in May or June before they arrive on campus. If you are a Bowdoin student and have never logged in to your MyAid portal, please click on “First-Time User” and complete the steps to set up your portal.

Tips for Logging in to Your MyAid Portal

- Go to bowdoin.edu/myaid
- Your Bowdoin ID refers to your six-digit numeric ID.
- Your password may or may not be the same as the password you use for other Bowdoin log-ins.
- You will be locked out of your portal after three unsuccessful log-in attempts. Please contact the SAO at sao@bowdoin.edu or 207-725-3144 if you are locked out of your portal and/or need us to reset your password.
- To avoid being locked out of your portal, please click “Forgot Your Password?” and follow the steps to reset your password if you can’t remember it.
- Be sure to reset your MyAid portal password when you receive emails prompting you to do so.
